Incoming students should present Copy of European Health Insurance Card, valid for the whole period of studies.

ISEGI-NOVA is prepared to receive students and staff with disabilities, but each case as to be individually analyzed.

2. The receiving institution will send its decision within 5 weeks.
3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI. *[It should normally not exceed five weeks according to the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education guidelines]*
4. Termination of the agreement

In the event of unilateral termination of this agreement, a notice of at least one academic year should be given, by the partner that wants to end with the Agreement. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.

[It is up to the involved institutions to agree on the procedure for modifying or terminating the inter-institutional agreement. However, in the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. The termination

clauses must include the following disclaimer: "Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict."]

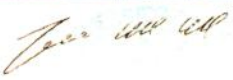
