#### 4. Termination of the agreement

#### F. Information

#### 1. Grading systems of the institutions

FNANCY38: In the Nancy School of Architecture system, each course unit is graded on a scale from 0 to 20 points. When a student does not take the corresponding examination or final assessment, this is reflected as absent. To pass a course unit, a student must receive a grade of at least 10 out of 20 points.
