If the student's exam grades are not yet available when you leave, please make arrangements with the proper office to have your transcript sent to you.

## 4. Termination of the agreement

The involved institutions agree on the procedure for modifying or terminating the inter-institutional agreement. In the event of termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. The

termination clauses must include the following disclaimer: "Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict."

## Grading systems of the institutions

D DRESDENO2: The grading scale ranges from 1 to 5, in which 1 stands for "excellent/very good", 2 for "good", 3 for "satisfactory", 4 for "sufficient" and 5 for "not satisfactory". Passing grades may also be qualified decimal numbers such as 0.3 or 0.7 to indicate tendencies towards the next grade.
