Technical University of Applied Sciences Würzburg-Schweinfurt - grading system



In the Bavarian university system, each course unit is graded on a scale from 1 to 6 points, and each numerical grade corresponds to a qualitative grade as follows:

from	1	to	1,5	sehr gut (very good)
from	1,6	to	2,5	gut (good)
from	2,6	to	3,5	befriedigend (satisfactory)
from	3,6	to	4,0	ausreichend (sufficient)
above	4,0			nicht ausreichend (failed)

Termination of the agreement

In the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 2026 will only take effect as of 1 September 2026+1. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.
