2. The receiving institution will send its decision within [4] weeks.
3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than [4] weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI. [It should normally not exceed five weeks according to the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education guidelines]
4. Termination of the agreement

[It is up to the involved institutions to agree on the procedure for modifying or terminating the inter-institutional agreement. However, in the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. The termination clauses must include the following disclaimer: "Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict."]

Description of Romanian grading system

The Romanian grading system is based on 10 possible points.

10 is the highest grade.

5 is the lowest passing grade.

The approximation of the Romanian grades to an ECTS scheme for the subject area is assessed periodically by the Council of the Course of Study within each faculty; the current for the Faculty is as follows:

- A, Excellent: outstanding performance fully meeting requirements: 10;
- B, Very good: a very good performance with only minor shortcomings: 9;
- C, Good: a good performance with a few notable shortcomings: 8;
- D, Satisfactory: fair with few significant shortcomings: 6 and 7;
- E, Sufficient: performance only meeting the minimum requirements: 5
- Fx and F, Fail: preparation totally inadequate: 4 and below

In our university 1 full academic year = 60 credits
