TR ISTANBU07 will send its decision within 10 weeks after submitting all required documents

3. The University of Antwerp as receiving institution will issue the **Transcript of Records** no later than 4 weeks after the assessment period has finished.

TR ISTANBU07: A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than [4] weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI. [It should normally not exceed five weeks according to the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education guidelines

4. Termination/modification of the agreement

Termination of the agreement or amendments in the data set above can be made annually, if communicated before 1 January. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agency can be held responsible in case of conflict.
